Eligibility and Guidance

The aim of the Big Warsop RoLo Community Chest is to support the Parish of Warsop by making grants to voluntary and community groups who are working to improve their communities.

How much do we offer in Grants?

Grants of up to £500 will be available

Who can apply?

Community and voluntary groups based in the Parish of Warsop wishing to deliver projects benefiting people living within the parish of Warsop

Groups/Organisations should be:

- Registered Charities, **or**
- Constituted Groups (Who have a set of rules and a bank account)

What will we fund?

- Capital costs, (the cost of buying equipment or tools)
- Revenue costs (General running costs, room hire, transport, volunteer expenses, cost of events)
- In some cases we may fund the cost of sessional workers or consultants

What can't we fund?

- Direct salaries
- Political activities
- Faith focused activities
- Items purchased or activities that have taken place prior to funding being agreed
- Individuals

Please note – The funds available for distribution are limited, therefore although all applications received will be considered, applications from organisations which have not previously received funding from the Community Chest will be prioritised within each round.
