2.1	<p>Project Review (3)</p> <p>Issues Vs Opportunities</p> <p>Maddy confirmed that the RAG status document mentioned in the last meeting will be sent out ASAP.</p> <p>Unemployment – Group feel that investment in training to date has been valuable but that further clarification of unemployment statistics and benefits information is needed from DWP.</p> <p>Children & Young People – concerns re the number of children in the Parish living in poverty, and in particular issues that affect children in the school holidays when external support in reduced.</p> <p>Older Residents - concerns re loneliness and isolation, is a community bus service needed. Michael Smith is going to investigate further.</p> <p>Health – High levels of mental health are a concern. Lesley to send a report pro-forma to Sharron in order to get some feedback from the Clearways Counselling sessions.</p> <p>Issues regarding GP access are of concern in the community, and people are being told that they have to book on-line. This needs to be explored further and taken up with the CCG.</p>	

Health engagement events/activities need to be more local and accessible to people in Warsop Parish.

Opportunities:

Getting the **Malcolm Sargison Centre** back up and running to bring back activities into the community. Community Group 'Friends of Warsop Vale' have now been set up and are working to improve life for residents.

The Shed – Money for next 2 years committed in principle for resource to support the development of the building, but match funding is required for Capital funding opportunities. It is starting to act as a Community Hub but more development is needed. Potential for Nottingham University to be involved in the design of the next phase.

Blakely Lane/Sherwood Forest Trust – Ambition is to have a centre of excellence for training in environmental skills. Would BIG Warsop be involved as ownership is an issue unless a long term lease was secured for the community? The group agreed that they need more information and would like to have a presentation from the Trust.

Sports Development Group (Meden Vale) – Parents are currently running activities and need support.

Development Trust (worker) – to provide 'umbrella' support for groups/community projects in the Parish going forward.

Investment in property and/or solar panels – is this an option? Is the return good?

Discussion about both of these ideas took place, the pros and cons were talked through. Who would take these sorts of projects on and manage them? Could houses be built on the land adjacent to Shed in order to generate income.

Infotech –

Infotech provides a key service to the community in the provision of Adult Education which is under threat due to increased costs for rent of space at the Town Hal. More discussion needed,

2.2 Current Delivery Plan

Finance Update – Most budget headings are on track to be spent. The Police laptop has now been cancelled. The charges from WEA are now confirmed to be £190 and the Creative Warsop Budget can now be finalised.

Bill and Mike will contact other areas and Maddy will draft a job description for the role.</p> <p>Project Updates</p> <p>ROLO – Need more representation from BIG Warsop – Michael Smith to join</p> <p>Defibs – EMAS have agreed to take on management of the defibs. The damaged defib case at Meden Vale has now been replaced. Lesley to rearrange cancelled meeting with EMAS to finalise everything.</p>

<p>3 – AOB</p> <p>Meden Sports Centre – NCC will not be putting out an expression of interest to run the centre. The pool will be drained in early April, and ‘school only’ access to certain areas of the centre. Can a community Leisure Trust be set up to approach NCC to see if they would reconsider and hand the centre over to their ownership? What is the role of BIG Warsop? If a Stakeholder group was to set up to explore this then BIG Warsop would have representation. Meeting to be requested with NCC and if there are further potential options then a Stakeholder Group could be set up.</p> <p>Community Consultation – How do we use the information gathered to build a new plan ASAP?</p> <p>Infotech – WEA have new workers and will be developing 3 new courses in partnership. Parents from Children Centre would like confidence building. Date set for meeting with WPC re Infotech provision in the Town Hall going forward.</p> <p>ROLO Event – Everyone enjoyed the event, feedback will be in next edition of W&D News.</p>
