

# Annual Review



Here is a quick recap of just a few of the events and activities that Big Warsop has supported during the last twelve months.

## October 2016



Seven people from the Big Warsop area attended a one-day first aid course funded by Big Local. The Level 2 Emergency First Aid at Work course gave local residents improved skills and knowledge of first aid to use in their current work roles or to improve their career or volunteering prospects. The course was delivered by **Vision West Nottinghamshire College** in partnership with **Warsop InfoTech**.

## November 2016



The **Oaklands Centre** in Warsop received £500 of funding from the RoLo/Community Chest fund. The Centre used the money to start a project to improve the entrance at the centre.

## December 2016



**Vibrant Warsop** supported the delivery of the Warsop Christmas Fayre, which received £1,000 of funding from Big Warsop. The indoor event was arranged, managed and delivered entirely by a group of local volunteers. It was hosted by **Warsop Youth Club** at The Shed, which provided the large under cover venue needed to welcome the various stallholders, fairground rides, and accommodate the 800 local people who visited the fayre.

## January 2017

The Spring Round of Big Warsop / **RoLo Community Chest** was launched. The fund supports voluntary and community groups and organisations in the Parish of Warsop by providing grants of up to £500.

## February 2017



**Creative Warsop** launched a programme of courses to inspire local people to become more creative by learning craft skills.

Big Warsop also funded a series of training opportunities in First Aid and Food Safety. The courses were delivered by **Care Trainers** and were aimed at giving people aged 16 or over who live, work or volunteer in the Warsop Parish useful skills for the workplace.

## March/April 2017

**SECURITY** Big Warsop once again funded free training for local people wanting to gain a security industry qualification.

The 5-day Door Supervisor Level 2 course was delivered by **Prosec Training / Meden Event Security** and accredited by HABC (Highfield Awarding Body for Compliance).

## May/June 2017

Big Warsop helped fund a breastfeeding training programme delivered by **Sure Start Children's Centre** aimed at encouraging more local parents to become breastfeeding supporters. The Big Warsop support funded additional crèche workers to care for babies while their mothers attended the course, plus some additional study resource materials.

## July 2017

**Sure Start Children's Centre** in Warsop delivered a baby yoga course for parents, and **Vision West Nottinghamshire College** ran a dressmaking course. Both of these courses were supported by Big Warsop.

## September 2017

An exciting new environmental project called the Future Greens was launched by **Vibrant Warsop** and **Eco-logic** who are looking for volunteers with a passion for nature, the outdoors and conservation. The projects start this month.



## August 2017

This month saw the start of a series of pop-up youth sessions funded by Big Warsop and delivered by **Warsop Youth** in partnership with **Sport 4 Kidz**.
