<p><b>2. Project Name - Celebrating how local children are leading the way in Growing Stronger and More Resilient in Warsop Parish</b></p> <p>This project would celebrate how local children, and schools, are growing stronger and more resilient, and how Warsop Parish is leading the way nationally with their Whole Parish Approach to resilience building.</p> <p><b>Background</b></p> <p>Vibrant Warsop, and its partners, including Big Warsop, have a range of Strengthening Community initiatives, and we have much to be proud of as a community. Vibrant Warsop's well received celebration report '<i>Growing Stronger Together in Warsop Parish</i>' was a celebration of this. One year on from its publication, we, along with our resilience building partner, Each Amazing Breath, have seen even greater strengthening community impact through the Take Five at School project. This project was funded via Big Warsop and it has achieved remarkable impact. Examples include:</p> <p>A) 1080 children involved across the Parish</p> <p>B) Example results of the evaluation showing from Sherwood Juniors give a flavour of this. The Year 5 class data shows that children self-reported that the Take Five practices resulted in feeling more positive about themselves.</p> <p>The whole class reported an average increase of 21% of feeling more positive about themselves. Not only that, the children who were feeling the least positive about themselves, reported an even greater increase – they reported a 48% increase in feeling more positive about themselves.</p> <p>The same class also reported that Take Five helped them to feel calmer, with the whole class averaging an increase in calmness of 28% and the children who were feeling the most uncalm before doing Take Five reporting a 49% improvement. These are outstanding results and Each Amazing Breath tell us that they are some of the highest percentage increases that we have seen in any school.</p> <p>We believe it is time to really celebrate. The reasons for celebrating are:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1) Celebrating will bring lots of benefits to the children and young people in the Parish</li> <li>2) Celebrating and showcasing all the work will be so positive and uplifting and it will help people in Warsop to feel justifiably proud to be leading the way nationally with young people led resilience building. We are the only place in the UK where all schools (infant, Junior and secondary) have a shared and joined up resilience building programme across a whole Parish.</li> <li>3) The profile and showcasing materials related to the celebrations will help Vibrant Warsop, and other partners, to help raise the profile of what is happening in Warsop. This has many benefits for local people, including it helping us to attract even more inward investment into the community.</li> </ol> <p><b>What the Celebration would involve?</b></p> <p><b>Celebration and valuing local youth leadership outcomes</b></p> <p>A Celebration event either in July 2020 or September 2020.</p> <p>The event will:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a) Celebrate and award certificates to 60 plus children who are the Take Five Ambassadors in all the schools in Warsop. These are the children who over the next few years will be the leaders of strength based growth across the Parish. They are an amazing asset for the community and this event will provide an opportunity to recognise and appreciate them</li> <li>b) Bring all the schools in Warsop together to celebrate and showcase their amazing resilience progress involving all 1080 children across the parish.</li> <li>c) Launch the Take Five evaluation impact reports funded Big Warsop. There will be 3 quantitative impact reports (one for each of the key stage two schools involved in the project namely Eastlands Juniors, Sherwood Juniors and Birklands) that will attractively showcase all the data and impact and provide some solid facts and statistics that can be used to attract publicity and showcasing of the Parish</li> <li>d) Provide an opportunity to attract positive publicity to Warsop, Big Warsop, and showcase the extraordinary progress the schools and children across the Parish are making to Grow Strong and Resilient. This is a key part of Vibrant Warsop's Growing Stronger strengthening Community Plan and we want to really celebrate and get some profile for the Parish, Big Warsop and the Schools</li> </ol> <p><b>2) Ongoing Parish Showcasing outcomes:</b> The event will be filmed and voices, ideas and excitement of local people and children will be captured. A showcasing film will be produced in the autumn term, and this will be used to:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a) Showcase to local people who couldn't attend the event. This, post event promotion, will aid the process of people across the Parish, becoming more aware of how amazingly the children are doing and how Warsop is nationally unique in having a Whole Parish Approach to resilience building.</li> <li>b) Showcase the work in the Parish to key stakeholders in Warsop, Mansfield, Nottinghamshire and Local Trust so they can see how well Warsop in doing</li> <li>c) Showcase the resilience building on local websites such as the schools websites, Big Warsop website, Vibrant Warsop website and community facebook pages</li> </ol> <p><b>3)Networking and building practical plans to bring alive the next phase of the vision outcomes:</b> The event will also provide a very practical and positive means for all the Parishes schools to network and come together. The schools all reported how valuable networking was when they were trained in Take Five and they have all expressed a desire to build on this. This will also aid building our collective year 2 vision for Growing Stronger across Warsop Parish.</p> <p><b>4) Resources to aid profile and income generation opportunities for the Parish.</b> Production of a Growing Stronger across Warsop Parish Year 1 report. Vibrant and Each Amazing Breath, who run Take Five, will co-produce the report and this will be a document that can be used in multiple ways including: showcasing to potential funders to attract more funding and resources into the Parish, and showing local people that things really are shifting and a very positive way. What difference will the activity make to local people and the Parish of Warsop?

There will be an array of outcomes of the project. These are summarised below, together with who, in Warsop Parish, will benefit.

**Outcome 1 - Celebration and valuing local youth leadership**

The benefits related to this outcome are summarised below:

Benefits to approximately 60 local children involved include:

- Opportunity to lead and be valued and listened to by adults and decision makers
- Confidence building
- Deepening of their understanding that what they do is important and special, and that they are making a valued contribution to their whole community, both now and in the future. i.e. This project will help further cultivate Warsop's growing youth leaders for years to come.

Benefits to all children in the Parish as, both locally, and wider afield, the profile of the resilience building they do each day in their schools rises and they reap the ongoing benefits

Benefits to the 6 local schools include:

- Chance to showcase their good work and be acknowledged for their progress and achievements
- Chance to work proactively together with other local schools and build robust relationships between schools aid future joint work
- Opportunity to showcase the quantitative impact evaluation reports and be able to have specific data to demonstrate that they are making a difference

Benefits to the Big Warsop Partnership and the whole Parish

- Opportunity to showcase how they have funded something nationally unique – namely all schools in the Parish doing resilient building involving all 1080 children and how this can grow year on year, and how children are leading the way.
- Provide an opportunity to attract positive publicity to Warsop, Big Warsop, and showcase the extraordinary progress the schools and children across the Parish are making to Grow Strong and Resilient. This is a key part of Vibrant Warsop's Growing Stronger Community Plan and we want to really celebrate and get some profile for the Parish, Big Warsop, Vibrant Warsop and the Schools.

**Outcomes 2 related to - Ongoing Parish Showcasing outcomes – namely the report and film that will be produced as part of this project**

**Benefits to the whole Parish**

- To have a really positive, dynamic and nationally unique showcasing film of the resilience building happening in Warsop Parish .
- Benefits to local people who couldn't attend the event but would enjoy seeing such positive and encouraging strength and resilience growing in all the Parish. This, post event promotion, will aid the process of people across the Parish, becoming more aware of how amazingly the children are doing and how Warsop is nationally unique in having a Whole Parish Approach to resilience building.
- Showcase the work in the Parish to key stakeholders in Warsop, Mansfield, Nottinghamshire and Local Trust so they can see how well Warsop is doing
- Showcase the resilience building on local websites such as the schools websites, Big Warsop website, Vibrant Warsop website and community facebook pages

**Outcomes 3 related to Networking and building practical plans to bring alive the next phase of the vision outcomes:**

Benefits to the next stage of Big Warsop's Action Planning processes. The event will also provide a very practical and positive means for all the Parishes schools to network and come together. The schools all reported how valuable networking was when they were trained in Take Five and they have all expressed a desire to build on this. This will also aid building our collective year 2 vision for Growing Stronger across Warsop Parish.

**Outcome 4 related to aiding the profile and income generation opportunities for the Parish.**

Benefits to the Parish through using all the promotional materials, impact reports and showcasing reports to aid the generation of more external funding for the Parish. This the project has the potential to help us, Vibrant Warsop secure more inward investment to benefit the local community.

5. Project Location

Ideally, we would like to run the celebration event in the Parish. The event would need a large amount of outdoor natural space combined with access to covered space in the event of rain. We are thinking that the Tudor Barn would provide an ideal indoor space and that this would provide easy access to The Carrs to use as the outdoor space. We would however need to do more work to ensure these sites were totally suitable.

We would apply for an event licence to run the event.
We would also ensure all appropriate Risk Assessment and Fire Plans were carried out

All schools involved in the current Take 5 programme, Big Warsop, Vibrant Warsop. This event will support the integration of a new resilience building programme being developed by Each Amazing Breath and Meden School.
