<p>On the 24 January we opened a Freedom café at Church Warsop at the Lifespring (Bethel) Church.</p> <p>Since starting the café the attendance each week has been around 12 people.</p> <p><b>Church Warsop</b>          Since opening on 24<sup>th</sup> January only 1 family has sought support at the centre, however people are accessing the café not for individual support but to avoid social isolation thus benefiting Mental Health.</p>

<p><b>Support that has been given to participants:</b></p> <p><b>Social inclusion/isolation</b>, different people have accessed the café's who would not otherwise be able to go to a café due to affordability. Everything is free and all who come feel equal. We have a small amount of toys at the centre for the children to play with.</p> <p><b>Debt</b>, supporting an individual to work their way out of debt.</p> <p><b>Benefit application</b>, support given to phone for a DLA application form</p> <p><b>Food Parcel</b>, food parcels given due to financial hardship</p>
