#### Introduction

The Community Mini bus project has seen growing success since the Spring, with increases in bookings as the year has progressed.

#### Activities undertaken during reporting period

You will note the diversity of the groups who have borrowed the bus over the first 6 months. It has worked for a variety of groups, interests and ages. Church groups, the Rotary club and Jigsaw, all have taken the bus on at least 1 occasion so far and plan to use the bus again in the near future. Beavers, Scouts, local Football clubs and local schools have all been regular borrowers and the feedback is positive. All groups have respected the "rules" very respectfully, to the extent where the bus still maintains an air of "newness". On top of the additional Community bookings, the bus has and continues to be used regularly by Meden School, being used weekly for sporting events, theatre visits and educational events.

# Outcomes the project has contributed to

The project continues to support local community groups to participate in numerous activities that otherwise may not happen due to cost or an inability for groups to be able to reach the event. The nominal cost applied, merely seeks to cover the petrol price and any ongoing maintenance that may be required. The groups involved have included church groups, the local Rotary Club, sports clubs, old aged pensioner groups etc.
