<p><b>Introduction</b></p> <p>We are currently waiting for the deposit of the funding but have plans underway for a community event bringing together intergenerational activities across Warsop, primarily aimed at those with children under 5 with older siblings. The aim is to offer family engagement opportunities and aim to provide events and activities, involving local parents and carers, to provide intergenerational opportunities to benefit the local children.</p> <p>These will help to raise aspirations through developing skills to participate and engage with others. They will involve improving health benefits and peer support models to benefit the wider community.</p>			
<p><b>Activities undertaken during reporting period</b></p> <p>Consultations with local parents and families revealed their wish for community discos and parties but these are hard to facilitate under current commissioning targets. The event will be held locally in October half term.</p>
