## Introduction

We are currently waiting for the deposit of the funding but have plans underway to use funding towards the following:

- Additional crèche worker to allow more people to complete a Volunteer training course who
  may need childcare.
- To provide, as requested by parents, an introductory Baby Yoga course.
- Added Value towards a parenting programme, 123 Magic, being run in October 2016.
- To provide a Baby Heart Start or similar course for parents to attend with the aim of training fifteen parents in early emergency response techniques.
- To provide an accredited First Aid course to Volunteers running play schemes at Meden Vale.
- To add value by providing an additional crèche worker for interested learners to attend a Special Needs course commencing in November 2016.
